eMPower 3.73

Updates / Fixes:

- eWebEditPro 2.6.0.7 editor
This version of eWebEditPro contains the needed workaround for the issues seen when installing the *Microsoft Cumulative Patch for Internet Explorer (Q323759)*.

eMPower 3.72

Updates / Fixes:

- Possible issue on UNIX systems when editing abs_path in the configuration screen. Wrong slash could have been added if not there when editing.
- eWebEditPro is undefined in a hosting configuration because empower_ewebeditpro.cfm uses empower_path instead of site_path. This doesn't break on most configurations because empower_path and site_path are usually the same. Same path issues fixed with StyleSheet and Display tags.
- Some of the buttons in eWebEditPro were not appearing or disappearing based on what is checked or unchecked for user group configuration.
- spreview.cfm now handles invalid doc_id more gracefully. It is now just blank.

eMPower 3.5

- Move Content – content blocks can now be reassigned to other templates in different content groups through the admin Workarea.

- New Display tag – makes it possible for any information in the eMPower database to be displayed maintenance-free and with any HTML/CSS formatting imaginable. See documentation for details.
- Macromedia Extension Support – eMPower tags are now wrapped in XML so they can be repositioned within programs such as Macromedia Dreamweaver.
- New Sample Site – eMPower now comes with a new sample site which has examples of every eMPower tag as well as help information.
- Default Content for Dynamic Content Blocks – now dynamic templates can have default content that is registered in eMPower so if no document id is passed through the URL the page is not blank.
- Hosting Solution – New design of eMPower allows any customer to use the content management system, even if the site is hosted by another company. The installation does not require you to install into the CustomTags directory or require mappings.
- JavaScript Syndication – Dynamic content can be created within eMPower and can be displayed in a HTML Web Site by using a script tag.
- Form Elements Toolbar – The Form Elements Toolbar enables you to add in form elements via buttons directly from the toolbars of eWebEditPro.

Fixes in this release:

- Library path for images, quick links, and files were not relative – this caused problems especially if the content was created on a development machine and then moved to a production machine.
- Refresh in Library for Oracle and MySQL users.
- New administration menu's within eMPower.
- "New" keyword removed from creating new content
- Smarter permission based content creating. A available content groups are based on user's permissions.
- Default font attributes are now passed to the editor.

eMPower 3.11

Features / Updates Added:

- eWebEditPro 2.0.0.34 added to eMPower
 - New buttons for international languages and more.
 - Color selection from customizable list of colors.
 - Content may be any language supported by Windows and the browser.
 - Menus and dialogs may be translated.

eMPower 3.1

Features / Updates Added:

- Added feature for LDAP / NT Authentication – see the Ektron Site (<http://www.ektron.com/empower.cfm>) for more information on how to purchase this add-on.
- Enhanced eMPower Utilities - various improvements to the eMPower utilities allow users to move content via a selectable datasource list, use a username and password if needed, and new error codes added for data integrity.
- Enhanced documentation – the documentation has been updated / modified for the enhanced changes to the application and added usability for new users of eMPower.

Fixes in this release:

- Oracle Date Fix – Start and end dates were not being properly formatted for Oracle when saving content. No changes to the eMPower database are needed for this fix.
- MySQL - When adding a user using MySQL, users.deleted would default to NULL instead of zero. This would possibly prevent users from logging into eMPower. The eMPower application now forces that value of '0'. No database changes are needed.
- MySQL Date Fix – When viewing the properties window for a content block, an error would be seen complaining of the date formatting. This has been corrected for version 3.1. No database change needed.
- Max Content Size Fix – When leaving the max content size blank in the eWebEditPro options, it would generate a javascript error when the eWebEditPro control loads. This has been corrected for version 3.1.

eMPower 3.0

Upgrading from eMPower 2.5 to 3.0:

Before upgrading from eMPower 2.5 there are a few items that you should review:

1. If you are using one of the 2.5 sample databases you should make a backup copy of the database prior to installing 3.0. The 3.0 installer will attempt to copy a new version of the supplied database files during the installation. eMPower 3.0 does NOT require any database changes from 2.5. Your old database should work fine with 3.0.
2. If your ODBC connection name is empower_sample the installer will change the file used by this name to use the new sample Web site database. You will need to either select a new ODBC connection name in the empower configuration or point the empower_sample ODBC connection to the correct database file.
3. The eMPower Web site now uses a new Application.cfm file. If you are using a modified version of this file you MUST replace the entire eMPower section with a copy of the new application.cfm file.
4. The functionality and location of the session manager file has changed. You can NOT use your old session manager file from eMPower 2.5. For this reason you should make a note of any special configuration settings you may have set in your 2.5 eMPower configuration, so you may duplicate them once 3.0 is installed. The session manager file is now located in [site]/empsessions/empower_sample_sessionmanager.cfm.
5. eMPower 3.0 REQUIRES a new license key. You must contact your sales person to obtain a new key. With an eMPower 2.5 support subscription; you can request this update from license@ektron.com. Without this new key you will not be able to edit the content blocks managed by eMPower.
6. eMPower 3.0 now allows the selection of using cookies or sessions to manage the application. The default is cookies. If you wish to return to using sessions you may select this option in the eMPower configuration.
7. Scheduling of content is now enabled by default. You will see a start date and end date field in the editor page. Setting either field will enable the content scheduling. Leaving the start field blank indicates the content should display immediately. Leaving the end date blank indicates the content will never expire.
8. The eMPower 3.0 installer will overwrite your existing 2.5 templates. If you have modified any of the supplied 2.5 templates you should make a backup of these prior to the 3.0 installation.

Fixes in this release:

- Max Content Size now allows you to leave field blank in the eMPower Administrator Configuration
- MySQL and Oracle Scripts are now included with the installation and can be found in the *lempowerutilities* directory
- Hyperlinks selections in the Library area have been fixed
- Email notification after document is published now has the correct 'From' name. Various miscellaneous email formatting issues corrected
